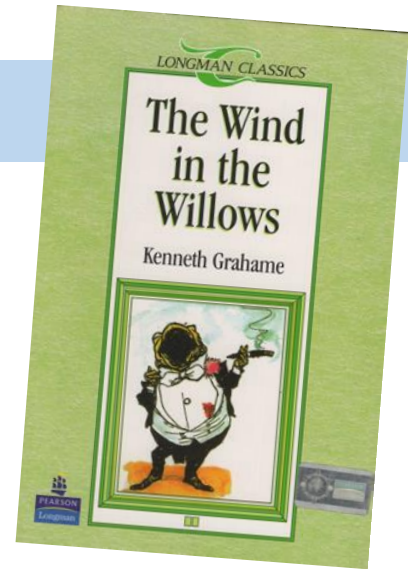

Kinderbuchklassiker. 2015 wählten 82 internationale Literaturkritiker und -wissenschaftler

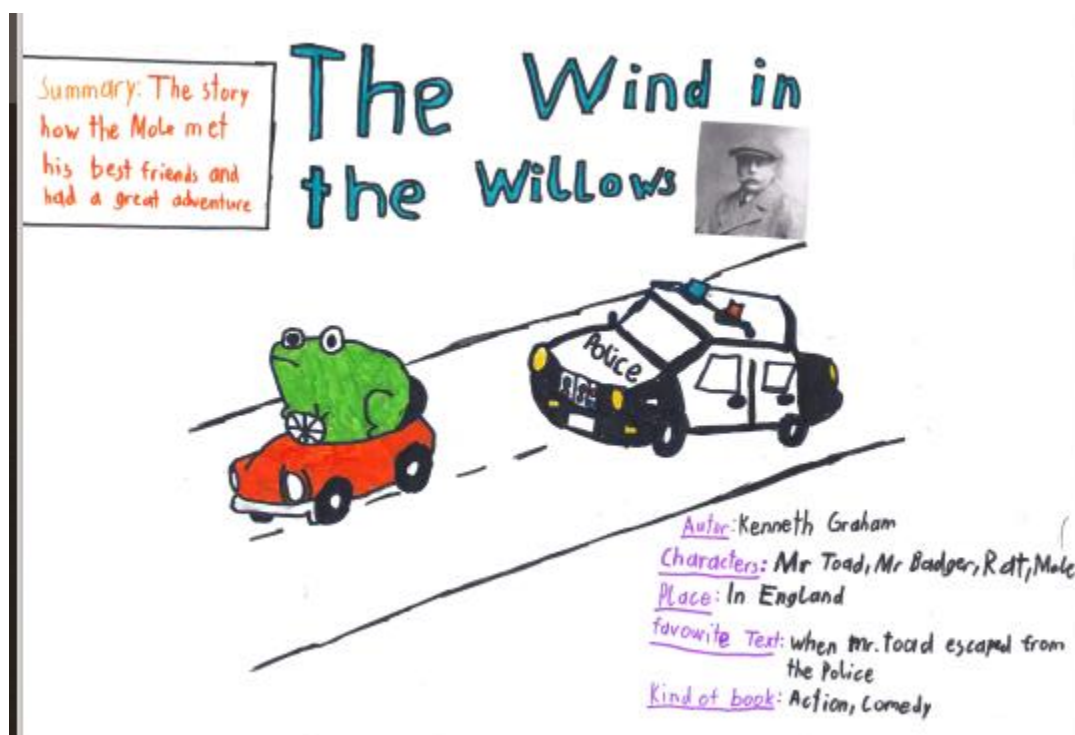
den Roman zu einem der bedeutendsten britischen Romane. Mit insgesamt etwa 25

Author: Kenneth Grahame

Characters: Mr. Badger, Mr. Toad, Rat and Mole,

Place: In the nature, next to a lake, in England

Scene: Where Mr. Toad dressed up himself as a washerwoman

Favorite text: And so he sang *When Toad came home!* - his last song.

Kind of book: Roman action, comedy

Summary: The book *The Wind in the Willows* is about a friendship between a rat, a mole, a toad and a badger. First the mole and the rat become friends. Then the mole also met the toad and then the badger. The toad is addicted to drinking cars, but he always has accidents until he goes to jail. He gets out of prison but he is haunted by the police. But he manages to distract them. During the time he was in prison, his willow was taken over by evil stoats and weasels from the wild wood. But the four friends manage to kick them out. The toad is so grateful that he throws a party and on the top of that he became a better toad.

- **The Author:** His name is Kenneth Grahame.
- **The Characters:** Mole, Rat, Mr. Toad and Mr. Badger.
- **The Place:** They live in a pastoral version of Edwardian England.
- Perhaps the most famous scene in Willows - now also a popular ride at Disney Land is Mr. Toad's Wild Ride. In the novel, the inebriated Toad, who is oddly large enough to drive a human-sized car, is frequently in trouble with the law and even imprisoned due to his addiction to jousting.
- **Kind of book:** Children's book, novel, comedy
